

If you are a **parent**, we hope you'll consider New Oakland's FACE to FACE summer program for your child if he or she is in need. Consultations are free and all insurances are accepted.

If you are a **medical**, **mental health or school professional** consider recommending New Oakland's summer program to families with children or teens with mental health challenges

that may be effectively addressed with an intensive, compassionate one- to two-week day program.

Each FACE to FACE summer day program session features:

- Daily outpatient intensive therapy from 9:00 am-3:00 pm, Monday through Friday
- Organization into age-appropriate groups for children, pre-teens and teens
- **Psychological testing** for every summer program participant to establish a baseline for care

Evaluation and treatment by a multi-disciplinary professional staff including psychiatrists, medical physicians, nurses, social workers, psychologists, professional counselors and other behavioral health professionals.



- Immediate psychiatric evaluations
- Psychiatric medication management
- Daily individual/family therapy
- Twice daily group therapy
- Psychological testing
- Daily mental health education groups
- Nursing evaluation and care
- Immediate post-inpatient appointment
- FREE transportation
